She organized an international festival of literature in Norway, until she studied stained glass at Edinburgh College of Art, finishing a Batchelor degree with Honours in 1999.

In the period between Edinburgh and coming to study glass at Academy of Art, Architecture and design (VSUP, Prague) in 2006, she lived out in the wilderness on the Norwegian West Coast, running a glass studio doing public commissions and larger non commercial art projects. She has had seven solo exhibitions, a dozen of commissions for public buildings, and have received public grants for her projects, one of the projects was also made into 30 minutes documentary for Norwegian national television.

This exhibition is her Diploma work for her Master Degree in Visual Art at Academy of Art, Architecture and design (VSUP, Prague).
